- insist on due diligence when the Village is considering agreements with concessionaires
- make certain that the personal interests of Board members are not substituted for the public interest
- make sure Village decision-making takes place in public in accordance with Open Meetings laws
- give voice to alternative priorities to assure we do not spend money unnecessarily on projects we don’t need

I believe the best outcomes are most likely when all alternatives are given serious public consideration before a decision is reached.
